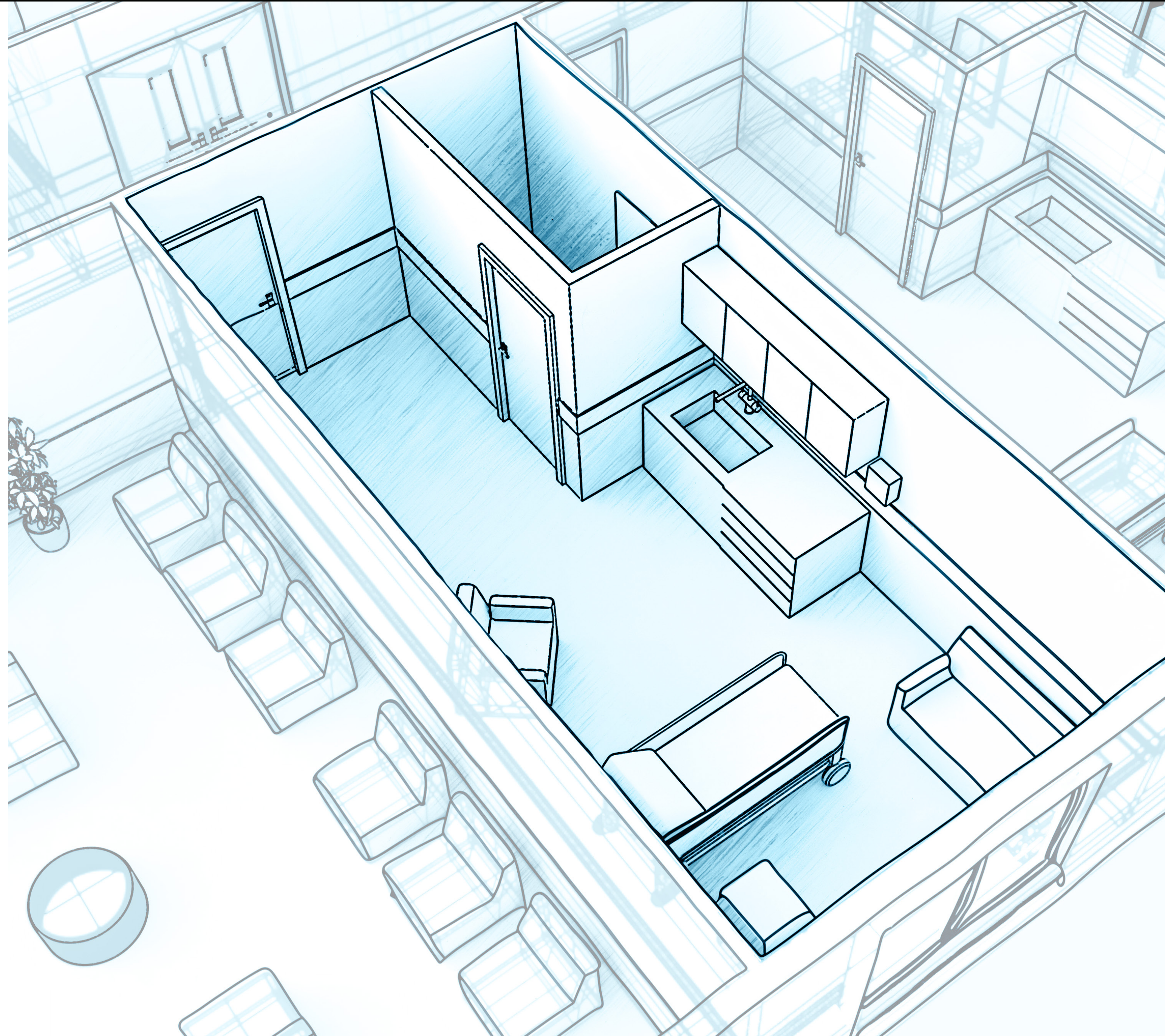

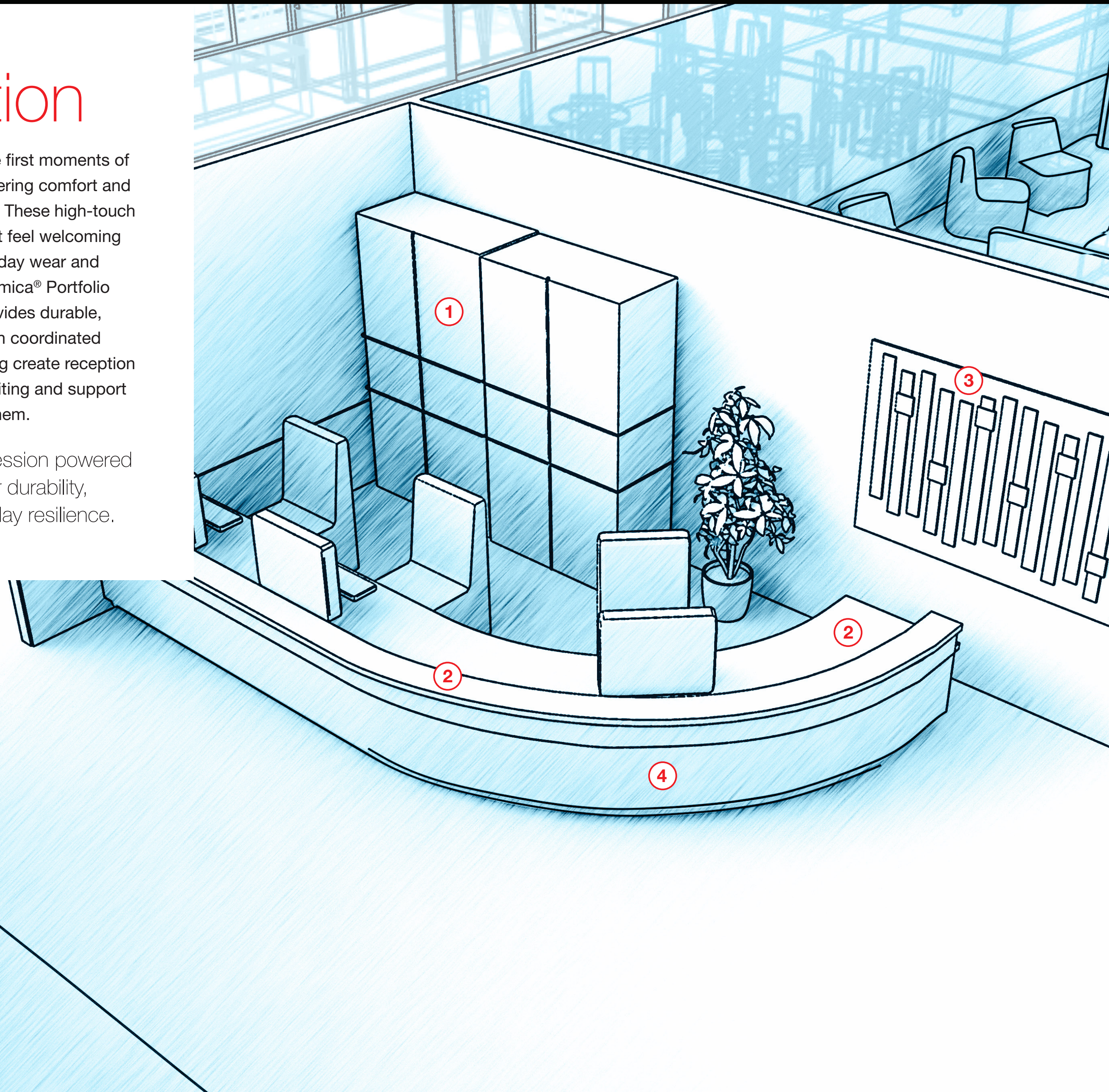

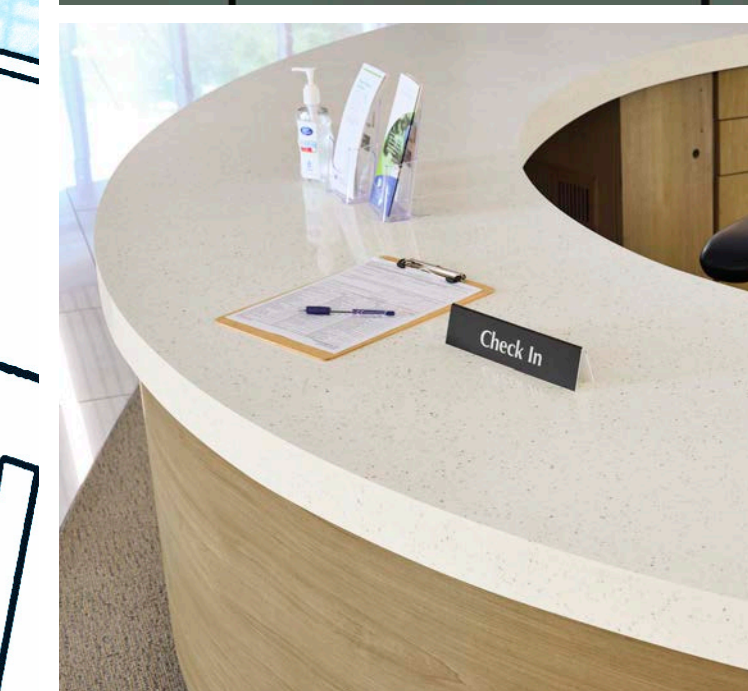
Reception

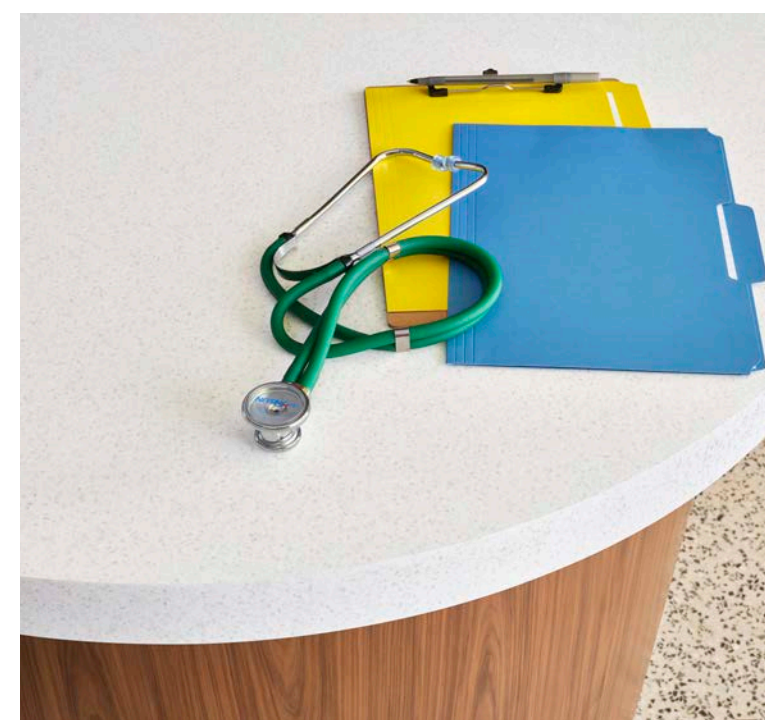
Nurses Station
