Committed to sustainability and experimentation, his work claims a balance between desire, materiality and sensitivity to the environment, establishing a constant dialogue between creativity and responsibility.





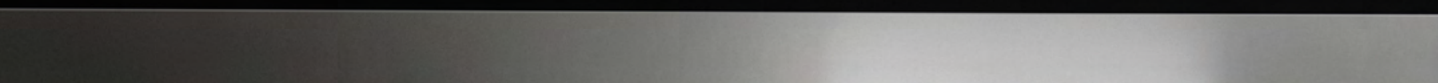
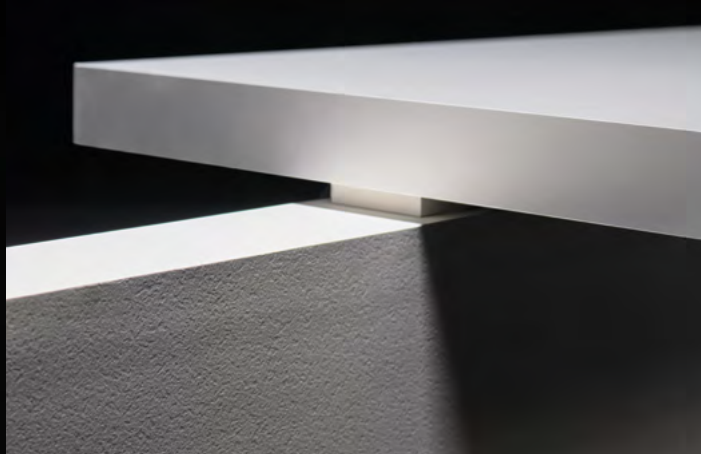

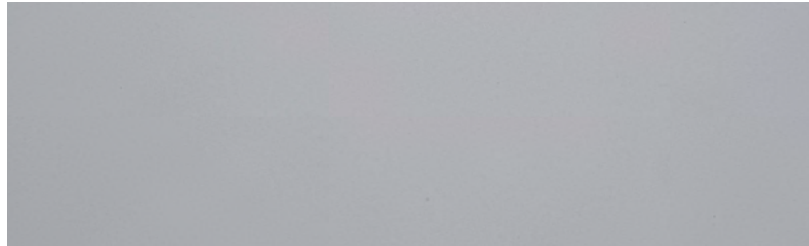
The design of this table transforms the geometry essential for stability into allegory of responsible development, seeking permanence and timelessness. It emerges from technical analysis and merges with artistic invention, reflecting balance and serenity in a changing world. Its essence evokes the cubism of *Braque* and *Picasso*, neoplasticism and constructivism, claiming a progressive abstraction towards straight, horizontal lines. **New Earth** is a visual metaphor for the spiritual harmony of the piece, beyond a simple artistic expression of the author.
